

Day Camp Guest Information

Timings

Day camps are from 1000-1500 and may consist of Nerf games, wide games, bush craft, treasure hunts, archery, and team tasks.

Please ensure you arrive **5 minutes** early as the so we can start the day with all the children on time.

Lunch

Please send all children with snacks, packed lunch, and water bottle for day. Sadly, in the present climate we are unable to provide the campfire meal.

Clothing

Please ensure that your child has the appropriate clothing for outdoor activities. Trainers, walking shoes or similar, a waterproof jacket, sweatshirt or fleece and we recommend long trousers however, shorts can be worn in hot weather. Ensure all extra items are named and are carried in a small rucksack or bag. In the event of hot weather, we would recommend that provide a sun hat, sun cream, spare clothing etc. as appropriate. No **crocs, flip flops** or **sandals** to be worn. Guests will not be permitted to play if they attend wearing these.

Weather

We are an outdoor focused activity camp with the ability to run activities under cover. We plan to operate in most conditions but in extreme cases (e.g. heavy snow or exceptionally low temperatures) we may have to alter the programme or postpone a session.

Activities

Nerf Games

In fair weather we will use the outdoor battlefield to run a variety of activities as well as using the evergreen woods for ambush games. Nerf guns and safety goggles are provided.

The Battlefield will be divided into team zones from which each team will remain and battle the other teams. There will be a series of new games to best utilize this procedure. Only one guest will be able to use the dart refill box at a time for loading.



At the end of each game, the darts will be picked up, placed into a pot for sterilising and cleaning by the staff. Fresh darts will then be introduced.

At the end of each activity, children will be required to use hand sanitiser or wash their hands.

All guests will be briefed to stay 2 steps away from each barricade to limit the touching in high frequent areas.

Where possible guests will be briefed to stay 1m away from each other during the games, or as we use during Nerf games, 5 steps.

The re-spawn or power boards will be a non-touch, clearly marked area where one guest can go in at any one time to get their power or life back once they have been shot during the Nerf tag games.

Guns – as above guests will be issued a blaster for the duration of the games. No other child will be able to use this and once finished with, will be placed into a pot for sterilising and cleaning by our staff.

Bushcraft

Each child will be issued an area for completing the tasks such as shelter building and snare making. This will limit cross contamination and keep 1m distance.

Demonstrations will be shown by the staff at a 2m (or more) distance.

Any help or guidance needed from a staff member will be given either from distance or asking the guest to distance from the snare/shelter.

Any equipment used during the traps and snares such as the paracord string will be placed into a pot for sterilising and cleaning for reuse.

Team Tasks

We will be offering a selection of wide games which will keep 1m distancing. Games include Simon Says, Horse Racing, individual obstacle course, blind man's trail and minefield. The blackout goggles will be issued and then placed into a tub for sterilising and cleaning by the staff.

None of the games will include any form of contact, ensuring we maintain the 1m distance.
